The Radioimmunotherapy Specialist (RITS) East will report directly to the VP of Marketing and be responsible for working directly with Oncology healthcare professionals across pediatric institutions within the assigned region. Within this role you will be able to educate targeted institutions about appropriate setup, process, handling, as well as administration of our Radioimmunotherapy product candidate, if approved.

The RITS will serve as the point of contact for all radioimmunotherapy technical knowledge, education, utilization, administration and support to both external customers and internal partners. The RITS will lead the assessment and technical setup for targeted radioimmunotherapy institutions. Within these institutions the RITS will work to educate stakeholders across healthcare specialties, including nuclear medicine and radiation oncology HCPs, to ensure the safe and appropriate administration of Y-mAbs products.

The RITS will provide information on operational logistics, ordering of approved products and helping to provide appropriate commercial calibration and other on-label technical support.

Key Responsibilities

Additional roles and responsibilities for Licensing and education and/or training activities include:

- Assess institutions for capability to administer and support technical setup for targeted radioimmunotherapy
- Provide sites with education and training on handling, administration, and radiation safety consistent with product labeling
- Provide account education for on-site preparation, infusion processes and education for appropriate radioimmunotherapy licensing and licensing logistics consistent with product labeling

- Appropriately respond to inquiries relating to safety and handling of Y -mAbs products from account's radiation safety committee
- Collect product quality reports and liaise with manufacturing to provide timely training support for sites
- Profile external accounts with focus on nuclear medicine and radiation oncology departments
- Partner and support internal partners with radioimmunotherapy technical expertise and training for educational materials and appropriate educational presentations to external partners
