- Utilize strong knowledge of the therapeutic landscape and Y-mAbs products / assets to generate congress strategy.
- Develop projects' (SCP, Pub Plan, Congress Strat., etc.) timelines and drive the process for on-time delivery of drafts and final deliverables
- Support advisory boards, scientific education and other relevant scientific communication needs to ensure aligned key scientific communication messages.
- Prioritize and plan work activities and resources, appropriately manage allocated budget, while executing multiple scientific communication projects
- Manage agencies involved in all aspects of publications (including software), SCP, and planning to ensure on-time deliverables
- Understand, apply and comply with publication-related guidelines for authorship and good publication practices (GPP3, ICMJE), and ensure that publication activities are within company policies, procedures and industry standards
- Establish and maintain up-to-date internal SOPs, POLs and guidelines within the area of responsibility
- Conduct compliant and transparent data generation, publication and dissemination. Utilize appropriate tools to document project status, drafts, author comments/ approvals, and reviews/signoff. Maintain records for compliance and auditing according to SOPs
- Set goals and objectives, and work both independently and within multi-disciplinary teams to execute global scientific communication strategy and tactics, and deliver high-quality scientific publications
